Admission is determined by need and is not based on religion, age, color, race, ethnic background, or gender.

General Hospice Philosophy

Holistic in nature, hospice care addresses the physical, emotional, spiritual and social needs of the resident with a deep regard for the individuality of each person.

Care is comfort based rather than curative. Symptom control, emotional well-being, and pain management are priorities.

Resident and loved ones are considered a unit of care as each is supported and assisted through this time of transition.

Whenever possible, the resident maintains control. Our purpose is to provide support to the resident and their loved ones in the hope of maintaining a safe, comforting environment to ease anxiety and concerns.

Emphasis is on living while dying; death being a natural part of life.

Bereavement care is offered as an integral service for thirteen months after the death.
