**2023 Build:** Mark reported that we are still on track for the foundation work to begin on July 8 with volunteer dates to start July 21. There is no construction schedule yet. Mark will send it out when it becomes available. Volunteer registration will be the same online process through Greater Rochester Habitat as it was for our last house. Each individual will need to register. If anyone would like to schedule a group workday, contact Mark to reserve a date.

The house is a two-story located at 108 Ackerman Street in the Beechwood area of Rochester. The homebuyer is Tatyana, a single woman with no children.

The wall raising will be coordinated by Laurie Streber, Director of Development & Marketing for Greater Rochester Habitat. Mark reported that Laurie gave a very good presentation at a recent Perinton Presbyterian service and would be willing to speak at other churches.

We have paid our \$28,000 for the 2023 build, and the Penfield coalition has contributed its \$32,000. The remaining \$40,000 will be covered by the four other coalitions. The Perinton coalition expects our annual contribution will be \$20,000.

**GRIB:** Greater Rochester Interfaith Builders has been meeting monthly and is going well.

<u>Logo</u>: Mark was informed by Greater Rochester Habitat that we are no longer allowed to modify their logo for our use. Several suggestions were discussed. Darren at Custom 100 has agreed to meet with a small group of us to design a new logo. Mark will request a full branding document from Julie Allen, Marketing & Communications Manager at GRHFH, to help with the process.
